1. Roll Call

Mayor Jonathan Godes called the meeting to order at 5:00pm. Present at roll call: Charlie Willman, Rick Voorhees, Shelley Kaup, Jonathan Godes, Paula Stepp, and Tony Hershey. Absent: Steve Davis.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Godes led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Pro-Tem Kaup moved, seconded by Councilor Willman, to add Council Comments to the Agenda.
