Action Requested:	Approval of the Gould Construction Bid for the Cedar Crest Water, Sewer, Storm Sewer and Roadway Reconstruction Project Bid BD2020-006 for \$3,928,331.90.
Department:	Public Works
Presented By:	Matthew Langhorst, Public Works Director
Background Info:	The Public Works, Water and Engineering Departments have been evaluating City infrastructure as a whole and have begun moving toward planning and design processes for several large problematic areas within the City. The Cedar Crest Subdivision was targeted as a problematic area with significant water, sewer, drainage and roadway issues all within the same project area. An RFP was sent out for Civil Engineering design services in 2018 to complete a design survey, utility mapping and the creation of engineering bid level plans and specifications for the large infrastructure project with the goal of constructing this project as a entire subdivision replacement project, aka a single phase of construction. In January of 2020 the City completed the design bid package with Boundaries Unlimited leading the design team and put a full bid packet out for contractors to review and provide pricing on. The City received 4 bids on March 3rd, 2020 ranging from \$3.9 million up to \$5.4 million. Gould construction was chosen as the apparent low qualified bidder at \$3,928,331.90. United Companies and Johnson Construction came in at \$4.2 and \$4.3 million dollars respectively with the high bid from Hyle Construction at the \$5.4 million dollars.

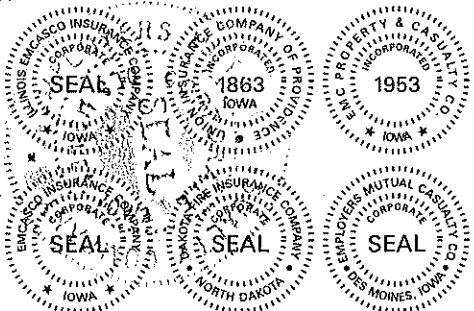

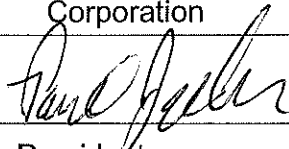

Work By Illegal Aliens Prohibited. Pursuant to Section 8-17.5-101, C.R.S., *et. seq.*, as amended, Contractor warrants, represents, acknowledges, agrees and certifies that:

1. Contractor does not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien who will perform work under this agreement. Contractor shall not knowingly enter into a contract with a subcontractor that fails to certify to Contractor that the subcontractor shall not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien who will perform work under this Agreement.
2. Contractor will participate in the electronic employment verification program created in Public Law 208, 104th Congress, as amended, and expanded in Public Law 156, 108th Congress, as amended, and jointly administered by the Department of Homeland Security and the Social Security Administration, or its successor program (hereinafter, "E-Verify Program") or will participate in the "Department Program" as established in §8-17.5-102(5)(c), C.R.S., as amended, in order to confirm the employment eligibility of all employees who are newly hired for employment to perform work under this Agreement.
3. Contractor has confirmed the employment eligibility of all employees who are newly hired for employment to perform work under this agreement through participation in the E-Verify Program or the Department Program.
4. Contractor shall not use either the E-Verify Program or the Department Program procedures to undertake pre-employment screening of job applicants while this Agreement is being performed.
5. If Contractor obtains actual knowledge that a subcontractor performing work under this Agreement knowingly employs or contracts with an illegal alien, Contractor shall be required to:
 - (a) notify the subcontractor and the City within three (3) days that Contractor has actual knowledge that the subcontractor is employing or contracting with an illegal alien; and
 - (b) terminate the subcontract with the subcontractor if within three (3) days of receiving the notice required pursuant to this subparagraph the subcontractor does not stop employing or contracting with the illegal alien; except that Contractor shall not terminate the contract with the subcontractor if during such three (3) days the subcontractor provides information to establish that the subcontractor has not knowingly employed or contracted with an illegal alien.
6. If Contractor participates in the Department Program, Contractor shall provide a notarized written affirmation to City that Contractor has, as required by the Department Program, examined the legal work status of employees hired to perform work under this Agreement and shall comply with all other requirements of the Department Program. RESOLUTION 2020-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, IN SUPPORT OF THE GOVERNOR DECLARING A STATEWIDE EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Colorado has declared a statewide emergency regarding the occurrence or imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (“COVID-19”) on March 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the cost and magnitude of responding to and recovery from the impact of COVID-19 may be in excess of the City’s available resources; and

WHEREAS, the City may need to expend resources not previously budgeted or approved; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the City to have emergency resources available to work to safeguard the health and safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, it would be appropriate and in the interests of the public health and safety, and would further protect property, for the City to support the State and Garfield County in their efforts to respond to the emergency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709 the City Council or City Manager is authorized to declare a local disaster emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. This resolution shall become effective if the City Council or City Manager declares pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709 that there is a local disaster emergency in Glenwood Springs, due to the imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from COVID-19 requiring emergency action to respond to and protect the life, health and safety of the citizens of Glenwood Springs.

Section 2. The effect of such declaration shall be to authorize the furnishing of aid and assistance under all applicable local and interjurisdictional disaster emergency plans.

Section 3. In the event of such declaration, the City Manager is hereby authorized to expend funds in response to the emergency not to exceed \$100,000 without prior City Council approval provided that such expenditures are ratified by City Council within 30 days. The City Manager is further authorized to suspend or modify the adopted policies of the City including, but not limited to, procurement and employment in order to respond to COVID-19.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such declaration shall be effective from the date of the declaration until the City Council determines an emergency no longer exists. Two copies of the declaration will be filed promptly with the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.

RESOLUTION 2020-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, ADOPTING AN ELECTRONIC PARTICIPATION POLICY FOR USE IN THE EVENT OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Glenwood Springs (“Glenwood Springs” or the “City”) is a home-rule municipality organized under Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and with the authority of the Glenwood Springs Home Rule Charter (the “Charter”); and

WHEREAS, Section 020.030.040 of the Glenwood Springs Municipal Code provides that four City Council members must attend a meeting to form a quorum to conduct business; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, the City Manager and City Council have authority to declare a local disaster or emergency; and

WHEREAS, city government must continue to operate during a local disaster or emergency, while taking measures to protect the health and welfare of its employees and officials; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, welfare, and safety of the residents of the City of Glenwood Springs to adopt an Emergency Electronic Participation Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated as findings by the City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Glenwood Springs hereby adopts the Emergency Electronic Participation Policy, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

Section 3. The Electronic Participation Policy adopted herein shall only apply upon the adoption of a resolution by the Glenwood Springs City Council declaring a local disaster emergency or the City Manager declaring a local disaster emergency pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709 of the Colorado Revised Statutes.

ELECTRONIC PARTICIPATION POLICY AT CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS DURING A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY

I. Purpose.

The purpose of this Policy is to specify the circumstances and means under which the City Council shall conduct regular and special meetings by telephone or other electronic means of participation, such as video-conferencing that is clear, uninterrupted and allows two way communication for the participating members ("Electronic Participation"). Electronic Participation has inherent limitations because Electronic Participation effectively precludes a member of the City Council from contemporaneously observing documentary information presented during meetings; from fully evaluating a speaker's non-verbal language in assessing veracity or credibility; and from observing non-verbal explanations during a speaker's presentation or testimony. The City Council finds that these limitations, inherent in Electronic Participation, may produce inefficiencies in meetings, increase the expense of meetings, and alter the decision-making process. As such, the City Council shall only utilize the policies contained herein upon the adoption by the City Council of a resolution declaring, or the City Manager declaring, a local disaster emergency pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, Colorado Revised Statutes.

II. Statement of General Policy.

The City Council may conduct a regular or special meeting of the City Council by electronic means only in accordance with this Policy.

A. Emergency Situations.

In the event a quorum is unable to meet at the day, hour, and place fixed by the rules and procedures of the City Council because meeting in-person is not practical or prudent due to an emergency affecting the City, meetings may be conducted by telephone, electronically, or by other means of communication so as to provide maximum practical notice. Meetings may be held by telephone, electronically, or by other means of communication if all of the following conditions are met:

1. A local disaster emergency has been declared pursuant to Section 24-33.5-709, Colorado Revised Statutes; and
2. The City Manager or the City Council determines that meeting in person is not practical or prudent, because of matters related to the declaration of local disaster emergency affecting the City; and
3. All members of the City Council, and at least one City staff member can hear one another or otherwise communicate with one another and can hear or read all discussion and testimony in a manner designed to provide maximum notice and participation; and

4. Members of the public can hear the City Council's proceedings and are afforded opportunities to participate in public comment; and

5. All votes are conducted by roll call; and

6. Minutes of the meeting are taken and promptly recorded, and such records are open to public inspection; and

7. To the extent possible, full and timely notice is given to the public setting forth the time of the meeting, the fact that some members of the City Council may participate by telephone, and the right of the public to monitor the meeting from another location.

III. Arranging for Electronic Participation.

A. The City Manager shall contact Council members at least twenty-four hours in advance of a regular or schedule meeting to provide notice of a meeting conducted under this policy.

B. The City shall initiate the Electronic Participation not more than ten (10) minutes prior to the scheduled time of the meeting. Upon disconnection during a meeting, the City Clerk shall make at least three attempts to re-initiate the connection.

IV. Effect of Electronic Participation.

A. Quasi-Judicial Matters.

In the event that a pending application is scheduled for a public hearing that is quasi-judicial in nature at a meeting at which this policy is in effect, the City shall advise the applicant of such circumstances and present the applicant with options for proceeding with the application. The applicant shall authorize the City, in writing, to proceed with one of the following options.

1. Conduct the public hearing under this policy with accommodations made for electronic public participation; or

2. Suspend any and all review and decisions deadlines until such time that the local disaster emergency is lifted and the City Council schedules a regular meeting at which a quorum will be physically present.

B. Executive Sessions.

In the event that the City Council holds an executive session pursuant to Section 24-6-402, Colorado Revised Statutes and Section 020.030.050 of the Glenwood Springs Municipal Code, participants shall be authorized to attend via Electronic Participation. Any executive session conducted under this policy shall be recorded electronically as provided for by statute.

V. Limited Applicability of Policy.

This Policy shall only apply to regular and special meetings (including work sessions) of the City Council and Planning Commission of the City of Glenwood Springs.

VI. Reasonable Accommodations.

The City shall provide reasonable accommodation and shall waive or modify provisions of this Policy to provide handicapped members of the City Council and Planning Commission full and equal access to City Council and Planning Commission meetings.
