4. Award South Midland Construction Contract

Terri Partch, City Engineer – Gave background on this item. She discussed the Transportation Commission concerns and solutions including bike and pedestrian access. She and Ryan Johnson noted water drainage concerns within the Four Mile area, as well as the roundabout.

Mark Gould Jr, Gould Construction – Discussed the project and clarified the incentive discussed above was to not work during peak hours.
